



Jeffco Connect Instructions to Allow Network Access (Parent)

In an effort to accommodate student's use of personal electronic devices as part of the overall learning environment and to provide access to a secure wireless network, the Jeffco-Instructional (BYOD) network is now available in the list of wireless networks District wide.

Students will not automatically be able to connect their personal devices to the Jeffco-Instructional (BYOD) network. Both the student and a parent/guardian must agree to opt in to the network through Jeffco Connect. Follow the steps below to be allowed onto the BYOD network. Students need to follow the instructions provided [here](#).

1.	Log into Jeffco Connect and select the child you want to edit. Click here to go to Jeffco Connect.	
		
2.	Go to the Agreements tab.	
3.	To View the district policies for Bring Your Own Device, click on policy (or click here). Click on "Yes" to allow your child to access the Jeffco-Instructional (BYOD) network.
